Rules and Regulations of Meeting of TransRadial Neurointervention

Article 1 General Rules

This meeting is called "Meeting of TransRadial Neurointervention" (hereinafter, "MEETRAN").

Article 2 Purpose

This meeting is aimed at contributing to the society by realizing minimally invasive cerebrovascular treatments through technical advancements in transradial neurointervention.

Article 3 Target Audience

This meeting is intended for physicians and other medical staff involved in neurosurgery, neurology, and treatment of neurovascular diseases.

Article 4 Activities

 MEETRAN shall hold workshops and conferences to achieve the purpose in Article

2.

2. MEETRAN shall hold these workshops and conferences jointly with medical device vendors and manufacturers agreeing with the purpose of this meeting.

Article 5 Members

Members are those agreeing with the aims of MEETRAN.

Article 6 Revenue

- 1. The operating fees of this meeting may comprise participation fees, advertisement fees, exhibition fees, funding, and donations.
- 2. The participation fee for members of this meeting is ¥5,000, but can be adjusted by the Board Members' Committee depending on the event.

Article 7 Board Members

The Board of MEETRAN will comprise the below-mentioned members. The term of the Board Member is until March 31, 65 years old. In special cases, board members can be dismissed for inappropriate conduct by a majority vote of the Board Members' Committee.

1. Committee 1 position President

2. Board Members 7 positions

- 3. General Secretary 1 position (simultaneously serving in the role of Accountant)
- 4. Accounting 2 positions Auditors

Article 8 Election of Board Members

- 1. The Committee President is elected by the Board Members' Committee.
- 2. The General Secretary is elected via nomination by the President.
- 3. The Accounting Auditors are elected by the Board Members' Committee.

Article 9 Roles and Remuneration for Board Members

- 1. The Committee President shall take the executive role in managing MEETRAN.
- 2. The Board Members shall form the Board Members' Committee that will maintain and manage MEETRAN.
- 3. The General Secretary shall supervise activities of the Secretariat.
- 4. The Accounting Auditors shall audit the accounts.

Article 10 Board Members' Committee

- 1. The Committee shall be established to manage the affairs of MEETRAN.
- 2. The Committee comprises the Committee President and the Board Members.
- 3. The Committee President will hold the Committee meetings as needed.
- 4. The Committee meetings will be chaired by the Committee President and managed by the General Secretary.
- 5. The Committee will discuss the methods of managing MEETRAN and make appropriate modifications.
- 6. The General Secretary or Acting General Secretary will attend the Committee meetings and create minutes of said meetings.

Article 11 Secretariat

- 1. The MEETRAN Secretariat is located in the institution that the Committee President or Board Members are affiliated with.
- 2. The Secretariat performs duties like organizing and preparing MEETRAN meetings, maintaining and storing meeting records, creating and storing rosters, creating and storing Board Members' Committee meeting minutes, and making financial reports. 3. The Secretariat performs accounting for MEETRAN, wherein the Committee President

makes a financial report annually to the Board Members' Committee after obtaining approval from the Accounting Auditors.

Article 12 Subsidiary Rules

Subsidiary rules necessary for management of MEETRAN may be stipulated by the Board Members' Committee.

Article 13 Revisions to the Rules and Regulations

Rules and regulations of MEETRAN may be revised with a majority of the votes of the Board Members' Committee.

Article 14 Establishment of Rules and Regulations of MEETRAN.

The rules and regulations of MEETRAN are effective as of August 10, 2019.
